 - SOQ4 Black is Beautiful (reminder/reiterate)
 - Donation update from Bob Davis
 - Our support of the national Black is Beautiful initiative resulted in a total donation of **\$1,000** to Uncommon Law, an organization dedicated to ensuring social justice services are available in underserved communities.
 - This amount is a combination of: \$10/ea. SOQ entry donations, donations by our members independent of the contest, and the Club's decision to donate the money normally awarded as the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes.
 - While many member's donations represented an "above and beyond" mentality, the social justice pit bull award goes to Julian Borrill who was personally responsible for \$420 of the total. There is a rumor circulating that Julian's success may have

involved making “offers that couldn’t be refused...” And to clarify, the pit bull award is endowed with bragging rights that expire one year from today.

- Uncommon Law is a 501(c)3, so donations are tax deductible. I will be sending out documentation to all donors as a reference for filing taxes.
